THE HOLY SPIRIT OF GOD

[Rom 8:14] For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

[Rom 8:15] For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received a spirit of adoption. When we cry, "Abba! Father!"

[Rom 8:16] it is that very Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

[Rom 8:26] Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we ought, but that very Spirit intercedes with sighs too deep for words.

[Rom 15:13] May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit

[1 Cor 3:16] Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you?.

[1 Cor 6:17] But anyone united to the Lord becomes one spirit with him.

[1 Cor 6:19] Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God, and that you are not your own property?

[2 Cor 1:21-22] But it is God who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us, by putting his seal on us and giving us his Spirit in our hearts as a first installment.

[2 Cor 3:17] Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

[2 Cor 5:5] He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee

[Gal:4:6-7] And because you are children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts,

[Gal:5:22-23] By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.

[Gal 5:24-25] And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live by the Spirit, let us also be guided by the Spirit.

[Eph 2:18] for through him both of us have access in one Spirit to the Father.

[Eph 3:5] In former generations this mystery was not made known to humankind, as the Spirit has now revealed it to his holy apostles and prophets:

[Eph 3:16] I pray that, according to the riches of his glory, he may grant that you may be strengthened in your inner being with power through his Spirit,

[Eph 4:22-23] You were taught to put away your former way of life, your old self, corrupt and deluded by its lusts, and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds,

[1 Th 5:19] Do not quench the Spirit.

[2 Tim 1:6-7] For this reason I remind you to rekindle the gift of God that is within you through the laying on of my hands; for God did not give us a spirit of cowardice, but rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline.

[2 Tim 1:14] Guard the good treasure entrusted to you, with the help of the Holy Spirit living in us.

[2 Tim 4:22] The Lord be with your spirit.

[1 John 4:13] By this we know that we abide in him and he is in us, because he has given us of his Spirit.
